Subject: Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Approval

Dear Commissioners:

On February 27, 2014, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received a document titled "OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Request to Update the Well BWM-13R Ammonia Background Data Set", dated February 26, 2014, for the Henry County Landfill (Facility) located in Henry County. This document was submitted by The Mannik and Smith Group, Inc., on behalf of the Henry County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), and requested to update the background data group representing the background ground water quality for ammonia nitrogen at monitoring well BWM-13R.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to the current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the director.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the information provided and concurs that this data can be added to the background data group. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the owner or operator is hereby authorized to update the background database for ammonia nitrogen at well BWM-13R, as detailed in the February 27, 2014, request.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04.

The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
