The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27-02 and the rules adopted thereunder, has reviewed the application for a permit with accompanying detail plans, specifications and/or information (hereinafter referred to as "application") regarding the above-referenced facility. This application has been approved by the Director subject to the conditions of compliance contained in the permit approval enclosed herewith and with all applicable laws, rules and standards. All construction must be supervised by an engineer or expert qualified in such work. Because the permit approval contains conditions of compliance, I urge you to read it carefully.

You are requested to submit within thirty (30) days of the date of issuance of this Permit to Install, the required permit fee balance of two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2500.00 - \$400.00 application fee = \$2,100.00), payable to **Treasurer, State of Ohio**. Payment of the \$2,100.00 fee within 30 days is a requirement of ORC Sections 3745.11 (Q) and (V). Failure to timely submit the required permit fee will result in an assessment of late penalties.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. It must be filed with the Appeals Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed at the following address:



PERMIT SUMMARY

This is a FINAL permit-to-install (PTI Number 879309) to modify the JMW Trucking Services, Inc. Transfer Station (Transfer Facility) located at 1800 Allen Avenue, Canton, Ohio 44307 in Stark County. The permit authorizes the addition of a bulking facility as a separate waste handling area at the Transfer Facility (Solidification Area). JMW Trucking Services, Inc. (JMW) is the operator of the existing transfer station. JMW is the permit applicant and operator. Slutz Properties, LLC is the landowner. PTI application Number 879309 was received on June 8, 2012, with the most recent revision received on December 10, 2012.

The Transfer Facility currently operates an existing rail transfer station primarily used to transfer construction and demolition debris and various types of solid waste. The proposed modification is for the addition of a Solidification Area to be used to solidify non-hazardous liquid and/or semi-solid wastes, such as industrial wastewater, cleaning solutions and sludges. The non-hazardous liquid wastes are to be mixed with bulking material (solidification agent) such as automotive shredder residue and flyash, until the resultant mixture passes the paint-filter test and meets the definition of a solid waste. The solidified material will be transferred to an off-site municipal solid waste disposal facility.

The Solidification Area is unenclosed, consisting of two 30,000 gallon steel tanks surrounded by a concrete pad. The bulking tanks will be equipped with a clay liner, as secondary containment, and with a leak detection sump pump. Solidification agents will be stored within the boundary of the new waste handling area. The new waste handling area will be sloped toward the bulking tanks such that any leachate will be collected and hauled to an off-site wastewater treatment plant.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached permit.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Director), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (JMW) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (solid waste transfer facility).
2. The proposed Solidification Area shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) which constitute this permit. There may be no

deviation from the approved permit or the permit conditions without the express, written approval of Ohio EPA. Any deviation from the approved permit or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of these plans does not constitute an assurance that the Transfer Facility will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste transfer facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.

3. Issuance of this permit does not relieve JMW of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations. In particular, issuance of this permit does not relieve JMW of the duty to comply with ORC Section 1509.22, as applicable, and the provisions of ORC Section 3734.02(P) and (Q), to the extent it accepts technologically enhanced naturally occurring radioactive material associated with drilling operations.
4. This permit shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI Number 879309, received June 8, 2012 and revised through December 2012.
5. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this solid waste transfer facility.
6. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-02(I), this permit shall terminate three (3) years after its effective date if JMW has not undertaken a continuing program of installation or has not entered into a binding contractual obligation to undertake and complete, within a reasonable time, a continuing program of installation of the Solidification Area.
7. JMW shall ensure that the state solid waste fees are paid on the combined weight of the liquid and solidification agent.
8. JMW shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the Transfer Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
9. JMW shall ensure that liquid waste is received solely from pre-screened customers.
10. JMW shall maintain current OAC Rule 3745-52-11 documentation available for inspection by Ohio EPA. This information shall be updated, at a minimum, on a yearly basis.

11. JMW shall ensure that materials used as solidification agents are non-hazardous waste, compatible with the liquid waste, and can result in a mixture that meets the definition of "solid waste."
12. JMW shall ensure that the Solidification Area and solidification agent staging areas are bermed to control run-off and run-on.
13. JMW shall ensure that liquid which comes in contact with staged solidification agent is properly contained and managed as leachate.
14. JMW shall ensure that bulk liquid wastes are not stored in the solidification basins. Bulk liquid wastes that are not solidified and unable to be transferred within 12 hours of receipt shall be mixed, removed from the solidification basins, and properly stored in accordance with all applicable rules and regulations so that the storage does not create a nuisance.
15. JMW shall ensure that each load removed from the basin after mixing meets the definition of "solid waste" as specified in OAC Rule 3745-27-01(S)(23). At a minimum, JMW must test every mixed load in accordance with method 9095 (paint filter liquids test) in SW-846 to ensure that only solid waste will be transferred to a solid waste disposal facility.
16. JMW shall maintain a separate daily log, in addition to the standard daily log of operations required by OAC Rule 3745-27-23(U), that lists the following information: date, the generator of liquid waste and solidification agent, description of the liquid wastes and solidification agents received, quantity of both the liquid waste and solidification agent used for each mix and the paint filter test results, and documentation to ensure compliance with conditions 17 and 18 of this permit.
17. JMW shall not accept for solidification any bulk liquid wastes that increase the potential for a landfill fire.
18. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except those excluded from hazardous waste or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
19. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M.

20. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of whole or shredded scrap tires for transfer to a disposal facility unless they are to be transferred to a scrap tire collection, storage, recovery, monocell, or monofill facility licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27, or to a licensed solid waste incinerator.
21. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of yard waste, source-separated yard waste, or mixed yard waste for transfer to a disposal facility unless source separated yard waste will be transferred to a composting facility registered or licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27.
22. Ohio EPA, Northeast District Office (NEDO) and the Canton City Health Department shall receive written notification of the construction start date not later than seven (7) days prior to starting any construction authorized under this permit so that construction of the Transfer Facility can be routinely inspected by Ohio EPA, NEDO and the Canton City Health Department before being placed in operation.
23. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23(Y), JMW shall not accept waste materials to the Solidification Area until all of the following events have occurred:
 - a. Site preparations for that area have been completed;
 - b. The certification report has been signed by the owner or operator and the certifying engineer stating that the Transfer Facility has been constructed in strict compliance with the applicable authorizing document and the certification report has been submitted to Ohio EPA;
 - c. Ohio EPA has concurred with the certification report;
 - d. The Transfer Facility has been adequately prepared for operation;
 - e. The prepared Transfer Facility has been inspected by Ohio EPA or the Canton City Health Department.
24. JMW shall provide for the following inspections and facility maintenance:
 - a. JMW shall provide for daily inspection of the Transfer Facility and completion of the Solid Waste Transfer Facility Daily Log of Operations, Form 3. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective measures employed, shall be made available to Ohio EPA or the Canton City Health Department upon request.

- b. The leachate collection system shall be inspected and maintained to prevent leaking, blockage, or clogging that may impede proper collection of leachate.
25. Prior to receipt of solid waste at the Solidification Area, JMW shall post clear instructions for using the Solidification Area and maintain the instructions in legible condition, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23(G)(1) through (4). All other site preparation, and other actions required by OAC Chapter 3745-27 for the Transfer Station, shall be complete so that the Solidification Area is adequately prepared for the operations proposed in this permit.
26. Prior to commencement of construction or any other activities authorized by this permit, JMW shall execute and fund a new financial assurance instrument or increase the amount listed on the existing financial assurance instrument in accordance with OAC Rules 3745-27-15 and 3745-27-17 for the current cost estimates of the Transfer Facility, including the costs for the newly authorized Solidification Area.
27. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations except as specified herein. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release JMW Trucking Services from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

END OF PERMIT CONDITIONS

EXEMPTION

ORC Section 3734.02(G) Exemption from OAC Rule 3745-27-23(O)(3)

JMW has requested an exemption from OAC Rule 3745-27-23(O)(3), which prohibits the owner or operator of solid waste transfer facilities from accepting waste containing liquids which can be readily released under normal climatic conditions, as determined by method 9095 (1996) (paint filter liquids test) in SW-846: "Test Methods for Evaluating Solid Wastes, Physical/Chemical Methods". The Transfer Facility will be accepting liquid wastes and transferring them to the Solidification Area to be solidified before transfer to a licensed municipal solid waste disposal facility. The Solidification Area is designed to handle solidification of non-hazardous liquid waste with a bulking agent until the resultant mixture passes the paint filter test and meets the definition of a solid waste.

Pursuant to ORC Section 3734.02(G), the director may, by order, exempt any person generating, collecting, storing, treating, disposing of, or transporting solid waste, or processing solid wastes that consist of scrap tires, in such quantities or under such circumstances that, in the determination of the director, are unlikely to adversely affect the public health or safety or the environment from any requirement to obtain a registration certificate, permit, or license or comply with other requirements of ORC Chapter 3734.

Because the Transfer Facility will be solidifying the non-hazardous liquid and testing each mixed load in accordance with SW-846 method 9095 to determine the mixture is suitable for transfer to a licensed municipal solid waste disposal facility, granting an exemption from the requirement of OAC Rule 3745-27-23(O)(3), which prohibits the acceptance of waste containing liquids at a solid waste transfer facility, is unlikely to adversely affect the public health or safety or the environment. Therefore, pursuant to ORC Section 3734.02(G), JMW is hereby exempted from the requirement of OAC Rule 3745-27-23(O)(3). This exemption shall remain in effect throughout the effective period of this permit unless otherwise revoked.
