The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27-02 and the rules adopted thereunder, has reviewed the application for a permit with accompanying detail plans, specifications and/or information (hereinafter referred to as "application") regarding the above-referenced facility. This application has been approved by the Director subject to the conditions of compliance contained in the permit approval enclosed herewith and with all applicable laws, rules and standards. All construction must be supervised by an engineer or expert qualified in such work. Because the permit approval contains conditions of compliance, I urge you to read it carefully.

You are requested to submit within thirty (30) days of the date of issuance of this Permit to Install, the required permit fee balance of twenty-one hundred dollars (\$2,500.00 - \$400.00 application fee = \$2,100.00), payable to **Treasurer, State of Ohio**. Please send the required payments to:

Payment of the \$2,100.00 fee within 30 days is a requirement of ORC Sections 3745.11 (Q) and (V). Failure to timely submit the required permit fee will result in an assessment of late penalties.

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You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. It must be filed with the Appeals Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed at the following address:

Issuance of this permit approval does not constitute expressed or implied approval or agreement that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with the plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above described source of environmental pollutants will operate in compliance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations, and does not constitute expressed or implied assurances that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with those plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will be granted the necessary operating permits and/or licenses. This permit approval is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part of hereof.

PERMIT SUMMARY

This is a FINAL permit-to-install (PTI Application Number 877761), which authorizes construction of the proposed Local Waste Services – Transfer Facility (Transfer Facility), located at 1300 South Columbus Airport Road, Columbus, OH 43207, in Franklin County. Local Waste Services, Ltd.. (LWS) is the proposed owner and operator, and is the PTI applicant. PTI Application Number 877761 was received on May 18, 2012.

The proposed Transfer Facility will be in the northern portion of their existing operations and maintenance building. A firewall has been constructed to separate the proposed Transfer Facility from the maintenance area and business offices in the southern half of the building. The proposed Transfer Facility has been designed in accordance with OAC 3745-27-21.

The waste will be deposited on the tipping floor and will be loaded into trailers with a front end loader. The leachate will drain to a designated collection point along the north perimeter of the tipping floor. Leachate will gravity drain to an oil water separator and then discharge into the public sewer.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached PTI.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The Director of the Ohio EPA (Director), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (LWS) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (solid waste transfer facility).
2. The proposed facility shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) which constitutes this permit. There may be no deviation from the approved permit or permit conditions without the express, written approval of Ohio EPA. Any deviation from the approved permit or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of these plans does not constitute an assurance that the proposed facility will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste transfer facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.

3. Issuance of this permit does not relieve LWS of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
4. This permit shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI Application Number 877761.
5. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this solid waste transfer facility.
6. LWS shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the Transfer Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
7. Nothing in this permit approval shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit shall not be interpreted to release LWS from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
8. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except those excluded from hazardous waste or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
9. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M.
10. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of whole or shredded scrap tires for transfer to a disposal facility unless they are to be transferred to a scrap tire collection, storage, recovery, monocell, or monofill facility licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27, or to a licensed solid waste incinerator.
11. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of yard waste, source-separated yard waste, or mixed yard waste for transfer to a disposal facility unless source separated yard waste will be transferred to a composting facility registered or licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27.
12. Ohio EPA, Central District Office (CDO) and the Columbus Public Health Department shall receive written notification of the construction start date

not later than seven (7) days prior to starting any construction authorized under this permit so that construction of the Transfer Facility can be routinely inspected by Ohio EPA, CDO and the Columbus Public Health Department before being placed into operation.

13. LWS shall provide for the following inspections and facility maintenance of the Transfer Facility:
 - a. LWS shall provide for daily inspection of the Transfer Facility and completion of the Solid Waste Transfer Facility Daily Log of Operations, Form 3. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective measures employed, shall be made available to Ohio EPA, or Columbus Public Health Department, upon request.
 - b. The leachate collection system shall be inspected at least annually and maintained to prevent leachate blockage or clogging that may impede proper collection of leachate.
14. All surface water control structures must be in place prior to beginning any other construction activities.
15. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23(Y), LWS shall not accept waste materials to any area of the Transfer Facility until all of the following events have occurred:
 - a. Site preparations for that area have been completed;
 - b. The certification report has been signed by the owner or operator and the certifying engineer stating that the Transfer Facility has been constructed in strict compliance with the applicable authorizing document and the certification report has been submitted to Ohio EPA;
 - c. Ohio EPA has concurred with the certification report;
 - d. All necessary equipment has been brought to the Transfer Facility;
 - e. The Transfer Facility has been adequately prepared for operation;
 - f. The prepared Transfer Facility has been inspected by Ohio EPA or the Columbus Public Health Department.
16. LWS must execute and fund a financial assurance instrument meeting the requirements of OAC Rules 3745-27-15 and 3745-27-17 prior to waste acceptance at the Transfer Facility.

17. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-02(I), this permit shall terminate three (3) years after its effective date if LWS has not undertaken a continuing program of installation or has not entered into a binding contractual obligation to undertake and complete, within a reasonable time, a continuing program of installation of the Transfer Facility.
