**RE: Closed Oxford Sanitary Landfill, Butler County, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC)  
Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Approval**

Dear Mr. Dreisbach:

On December 20, 2011, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), Southwest District Office (SWDO), received a document titled "*Statistical Analysis Program for Ground-Water Quality Monitoring Oxford Sanitary Landfill, Butler County, Ohio. (Revision 4) & Request to update background in accordance with OAC 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g)*", for the Closed Oxford Sanitary Landfill (Facility) located in Butler County. This document was submitted by Eagon & Associates, Inc. (EAI), on behalf of city of Oxford. The facility has requested approval to update background ground water data for monitoring well MW-9.

Pursuant to Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data has been statistically compared to current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable by the Director.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the proposal and concurs that sodium and chloride concentrations in well MW-9 are attributed to natural variability in the ground water. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the Facility is authorized to add data from July 2009 through November 2011 to the background data in well MW-9.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission

(Commission) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio". The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce this amount if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
