The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27-02 and the rules adopted thereunder, has reviewed the application for a permit with accompanying detail plans, specifications and/or information (hereinafter referred to as "application") regarding the above-referenced facility. This application has been approved by the Director subject to the conditions of compliance contained in the permit approval enclosed herewith and with all applicable laws, rules and standards. You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. It must be filed with the Appeals Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed at the following address:

PERMIT SUMMARY

This is a FINAL permit-to-install modification (PTI modification number 948258) to modify the Universal Disposal, Inc. Solid Waste Transfer Station (Transfer Facility) located at 9954 Old State Road, Chardon, Ohio 44024 in Geauga County. The permit authorizes an extension of the building and conversion of the existing floors to approved waste handling floors. Universal Disposal, Inc. (Universal Disposal) is the current and proposed operator and the PTI applicant, and shares as landowner with Shirley & Murl Clemson. PTI modification number 948258 was received on July 12, 2013, with the most recent revision received on September 18, 2013.

Universal Disposal currently operates an existing transfer station primarily used to compact and transfer municipal solid waste from portable containers under PTI Number 781194, approved August 26, 2011. Universal Disposal is modifying the Facility by expanding the waste handling area and changing the design of the leachate collection system. Current operations using portable containers and a compactor will continue. The modification is converting the existing upper and lower floor of the Facility to approved waste handling floors. A new floor trench with a grit collection chamber will be added to the upper and lower floors to help improve the leachate collection system. The current building will be expanded by 1,850 square feet, which will include an expanded waste handling floor. The expanded waste handling floor will be tied into the leachate collection system.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached permit.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Director), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (Universal Disposal) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (solid waste transfer facility).
2. The proposed Transfer Facility shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) which constitutes this permit. There may be no deviation from the approved permit or permit conditions without the express, written approval of Ohio EPA. Any deviation from the approved permit or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of these plans does not constitute an assurance that the proposed Transfer Facility will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste transfer facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.

3. Issuance of this permit does not relieve Universal Disposal of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
4. This permit shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI application Number 948258, received July 12, 2013 and revised through September 18, 2013.
5. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this solid waste transfer facility.
6. Universal Disposal shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the Transfer Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
7. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except those excluded from hazardous waste or infectious waste regulation by OAC Chapter 3734.
8. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M.
9. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of whole or shredded scrap tires for transfer to a disposal facility unless they are to be transferred to a scrap tire collection, storage, recovery, monocell, or monofill facility licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27, or to a licensed solid waste incinerator.
10. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of yard waste, source-separated yard waste, or mixed yard waste for transfer to a disposal facility unless source separated yard waste will be transferred to a composting facility registered or licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27.
11. Ohio EPA, Northeast District Office (NEDO) and Geauga County Health Department shall receive written notification of the construction start date not later than seven (7) days prior to starting any construction authorized under this permit so that construction of the Transfer Facility can be routinely inspected by Ohio EPA, NEDO and Geauga County Health Department before being placed in operation.
12. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23(Y), Universal Disposal shall not place waste on the waste handling floors until all of the following events have occurred:
 - a. Site preparations for that area have been completed including:
 - i. Building addition to lower level floor;
 - ii. Installation of new waste handling floors;

- iii. Installation of new components for the leachate collection system;
 - b. The certification report has been signed by the owner or operator and the certifying engineer stating that the Transfer Facility has been constructed in strict compliance with the applicable authorizing document and the certification report has submitted to Ohio EPA;
 - c. Ohio EPA has concurred with the certification report;
 - d. The Transfer Facility has been adequately prepared for operation;
 - e. The prepared Transfer Facility has been inspected by Ohio EPA or the Geauga County Health Department.
13. Universal Disposal shall provide for the following inspections and facility maintenance:
- a. Universal Disposal shall provide for daily inspection of the Transfer Facility and completion of the Solid Waste Transfer Facility Daily Log of Operations, Form 3. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective measures employed, shall be made available to Ohio EPA or the Geauga County Health District upon request.
 - b. The leachate collection system shall be inspected and maintained to prevent leaking, blockage, or clogging that may impede proper collection of leachate.
14. Prior to commencement of construction or any other activities authorized by this permit, Universal Disposal shall execute and fund a new financial assurance instrument or increase the amount listed on the existing financial assurance instrument in accordance with OAC Rules 3745-27-15 and 3745-27-17 for the current cost estimates of the Transfer Facility, including the costs resulting from expansion of the waste handling area.
15. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release Universal Disposal from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
