Dear Ms. Shipp:

On July 2, 2001, Hull and Associates, Inc. submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) a request, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(E)(7)(b), to reinstate detection monitoring for ground water monitoring well BW-12 at the Noble Road Landfill (Facility).


Monitoring well BW-12 is currently in the ground water quality assessment program. Even though the owner/operator did not present arguments relative to the presence of outliers in the background data set, Ohio EPA determined that the first two data points in the background data set were outliers. When the outliers were removed, subsequent statistical analysis resulted in the remaining data being normally distributed and below the prediction limit for sodium.

Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E)(7)(b), I hereby approve this demonstration and the owner/operator of Noble Road Landfill may resume ground water detection monitoring at the landfill for BW-12.

See the attached Appendix for a detailed account of Ohio EPA's review of these events.

Should future or existing ground water sampling results indicate statistically significant increases in ground water quality for other parameters, the facility owner/operator will be required to enter into assessment monitoring in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E), or obtain approval pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c) to remain in detection monitoring.
