Dear Mr. Hall:

On April 17, 1997, the Fulton County Commissioners, owner of the Closed Fulton County Landfill, submitted to Ohio EPA an Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan (Plan). The Plan was revised by Hull & Associates, in accordance with the first Notice of Deficiency (NOD) dated June 19, 1998. The revised Plan was received by Ohio EPA on November 17, 1998. The Plan was revised again in accordance with the second NOD dated December 2, 1999. The revised Plan was received by Ohio EPA on April 12, 2000. An explosive gas monitoring plan certification report was received by Ohio EPA on January 11, 2001. A final Plan, which incorporated the certification report and all previous Plan revisions was received by Ohio EPA on December 20, 2001.

The Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan submitted to Ohio EPA on December 20, 2001, by Hull & Associates, on behalf of the Fulton County Commissioners, consists of the following documents:

1. Explosive Gas Monitoring System Design; dated December 2001, and
2. Explosive Gas Monitoring, Sampling, and Reporting Procedures; dated December 2001,

The Plan meets the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27-12, effective June 1, 1994, and is hereby approved by Ohio EPA with the following condition:

1. The Director of Environmental Protection (Director), or a representative authorized by the Director, may enter the premises of the above named applicant at any time to inspect, conduct tests, or examine records and reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the explosive gas monitoring system, or for any other lawful purpose.

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Issuance of this approval does not constitute expressed or implied agreement that the monitoring of the facility, if performed and implemented in accordance with the approved explosive gas monitoring plan and/or its terms and conditions, will constitute compliance with applicable State and Federal laws, rules, and regulations, nor does issuance of this plan approval assure that necessary operating permits or licenses will be granted.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the ground upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission.
