

Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan Approval

Dear Mr. Richardson:

On February 18, 1997, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO) received an Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan (EGMP) titled "Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan International Paper, Hodapp Landfill, Hamilton, Ohio" for the closed Hodapp Landfill (Facility) located in Butler County. Subsequent revisions were submitted to Ohio EPA, SWDO on April 30, 1998; November 23, 2001; and June 28, 2002. The EGMP was submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-12.

The EGMP is comprised of the following documents:

- Explosive Gas Monitoring System Design; dated June 2002
- Explosive Gas Monitoring, Sampling, and Reporting Procedures; dated June 2002

The revised EGMP is hereby approved by Ohio EPA with the following conditions.

1. The Director of Environmental Protection (Director), or a representative authorized by the Director, may enter the premises of the above named applicant at any time during construction or operation to inspect, conduct tests, or examine records and reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the explosive gas monitoring system, or for any other lawful purpose.
2. Issuance of this explosive gas monitoring plan approval does not constitute expressed or implied agreement that the monitoring of the facility performed and implemented in accordance with the approved explosive gas monitoring plan and/or its terms and conditions will constitute compliance with applicable state and federal

laws, rules, and regulations, nor does issuance of this plan approval assure that necessary operating permits or licenses will be granted.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and maybe appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the ground upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the action. A copy of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
