On April 30, 2002, an explosive gas monitoring plan was submitted by The Payne Firm, Inc., on behalf of the City of Loveland for the Harper Avenue Landfill. The explosive gas monitoring plan was submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-12, with final revisions on November 27, 2002.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the plan and found it to be in compliance with OAC Rule 3745-27-12. Therefore, Ohio EPA approves the Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan for the City of Loveland (Harper Avenue) Landfill.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the director's action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three days after the appeal is filed with the Commission.
