

The above named entity is hereby issued a permit approval (permit-to-install) for the above described source pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-31. Issuance of this permit approval (permit-to-install) does not constitute expressed or implied approval or agreement that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with the plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above described source of environmental pollutants will operate in compliance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations, and does not constitute expressed or implied assurances that if constructed and/or modified in accordance with those plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above described source of environmental pollutants will be granted the necessary operating permits and/or licenses. This permit approval (permit-to-install) is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3734.44, the applicant has exhibited sufficient reliability, expertise, and competency to operate the solid waste facility. This determination is made based upon review of the disclosure statements submitted pursuant to ORC Section 3734.42.

PERMIT SUMMARY

This permit approval (PTI Number 05-11359) authorizes construction of the proposed Evendale Transfer Station. This facility will be owned and operated by Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC and is proposed to be located off of Evendale Drive, approximately 2,000 feet south of the intersection of Sharon Road and Evendale Drive. The proposed facility will consist of an enclosed building and will process approximately 1,000 tons per day of solid waste and source separated recyclable materials. The facility will be equipped with a leachate collection system that ties into a municipal sewer system.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, this permit approval.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The Director of Environmental Protection (director), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above named applicant (permittee) during construction and operation at any reasonable time for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above described solid waste facility.
2. The facility shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted as part of the application for this permit to the director. There may be no deviation from the approved plans without the express, written approval of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA). Any deviation from the approved plans or the permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of these plans does not constitute an assurance that the proposed facility will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.
3. Issuance of this permit approval does not relieve the permittee of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
4. This permit approval shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI Application Number 05-11359.
5. This permit approval may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapters 3745-27 and 3745-31 applicable to this solid waste facility.

6. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-31-06(A), this permit approval shall terminate 18 months after its effective date if the owner or operator has not undertaken a continuing program of installation or modification or has not entered into a binding contractual obligation to undertake and complete within a reasonable time a continuing program of installation or modification. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-31-06(C), this deadline may be extended by up to 12 months if application is made to the director no less than 60 days prior to the expiration of the 18-month period and the party shows just cause for any such extension.
7. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the solid waste transfer facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
8. Nothing in this permit approval shall be interpreted to release the permittee from responsibility under ORC Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
9. This permit approval does not include approval for the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious waste, except those excluded from hazardous waste or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
10. This permit approval does not provide for the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M. No such asbestos-containing waste material may be accepted without first obtaining the necessary permits from Ohio EPA.
11. This permit approval does not provide for the acceptance for transfer to a disposal facility of whole or shredded scrap tires unless they are to be transferred to a scrap tire collection, storage, recovery, monocell, or monofill facility licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27 or to a licensed solid waste incinerator.
12. This permit approval does not provide for the acceptance for transfer to a disposal facility of yard waste, source-separated yard waste, or mixed yard waste unless source-separated yard waste will be transferred to a composting facility registered or licensed in accordance with OAC Chapter 3745-27.
13. Ohio EPA, Southwest District Office (SWDO) and the Hamilton County General Health District shall be notified of the construction starting date prior to the start of construction of the facility so that the facility can be routinely inspected by Ohio EPA, SWDO and the Hamilton County General Health District before being placed in operation.

14. The permittee shall provide for the following inspections and maintenance of the facility
 - a. The permittee shall provide for daily inspection of the facility and completion of the Solid Waste Transfer Facility Daily Log of Operations - Form 3. Written results of the inspections, including any corrective measures employed, shall be made available to Ohio EPA, SWDO and the Hamilton County General Health District upon request.
 - b. The leachate collection system shall be inspected and maintained to prevent blockage or clogging that may impede proper collection of leachate.
15. All surface water control structures must be in place prior to beginning any other construction activities.
16. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-23(Y) the facility shall not accept waste materials to any area of the facility until all of the following events have occurred:
 - a. Site preparations for that area have been completed;
 - b. The certification report has been submitted;
 - c. The financial assurance instrument has been executed and funded;
 - d. All necessary equipment has been brought to the facility;
 - e. The facility has been adequately prepared for operation; and
 - f. The prepared facility has been inspected by the Hamilton County General Health District.
17. Pursuant to ORC Sections 3745.11(Q) and (V), payment of the solid waste permit-to-install fee balance, in the amount of \$2,100.00 payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio", shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Attn: Fiscal Administration, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049. The fee balance shall be submitted within 30 days of the effective date of this permit approval. Failure to timely submit the required fee balance will result in assessment of late penalties in accordance with ORC Sections 3745.11(Q) and (V).
