**Re: Marion City Landfill, Marion County
Corrective Measures Plan Approval**

Dear Mr. Osborn:

Ohio EPA has completed its review of the revised Corrective Measures Plan (CMP) dated October 2002 for the closed Marion City Landfill located in Marion County. The original CMP was submitted to Ohio EPA in April 1994 and was later revised in July 1999 and March 2002. These plans were prepared and submitted in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(F).

The revised CMP dated October 2002 meets the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F). Therefore, the plan and the selected corrective measure, titled "No Further Action," are hereby approved with the following conditions:

1. Throughout the life of the approved CMP, the monitoring network wells screened in the uppermost aquifer system are to be monitored in accordance with the approved CMP which specifies the following schedule:
 - a. At least semi-annually, all aquifer wells shall be tested for parameters 1 through 66 of Appendix I of OAC Rule 3745-27-10.
 - b. At least annually, all aquifer wells shall be tested for all the parameters of Appendix I of OAC Rule 3745-27-10.
 - c. At least once every two years, all compliance wells shall be tested for all the parameters of Appendices I and II of OAC Rule 3745-27-10.
2. Throughout the life of the approved CMP, the semi-annual determinations of rate, extent, and concentration shall continue in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E)(8).

3. Throughout the life of the approved CMP, the list of concentration level goals, established by OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F)(7) and documented in Table 10 of the October 2002 CMP, shall be updated to reflect any new contamination plume of constituents detected during the sampling events conducted in accordance with Condition Number 1, above.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the commission not later than 30 days after notice of the director's action. A copy of the appeal must be served on the director within three days of filing with the commission. An appeal may be filed with the commission at the following address:
