**Re: Cherokee Run Landfill, Logan County  
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c) Approval**

Dear **Mr. Saylor**:

By correspondence dated **July 9, 2004**, the owner/operator of **Cherokee Run Landfill** located in Logan County reported a statistically significant increase for ammonia at monitoring well MW-25.

A ground water demonstration dated **August 25, 2004**, was submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO) indicating that the statistical exceedance noted above was caused by factors other than a release from the landfill. This report was received by Ohio EPA, SWDO on August 27, 2004. Upon review of the information submitted, Ohio EPA does concur with the demonstration that a variation in the ground water quality is not a result of the landfill for monitoring well MW-25.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c), the owner /operator is hereby authorized to continue the detection monitoring program at **Cherokee Run Landfill** for monitoring well MW-25, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C) and (D). Upon the effective date of this approval, the owner/operator is not required to comply with OAC 3745-27-10(E) and (F) for the aforementioned sampling event in regard to well MW-25.

Should future or existing ground water sampling results indicate statistically significant increases in ground water monitoring parameters, the facility owner/operator will be required to enter into assessment monitoring in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E) or obtain an approval to remain in the detection monitoring program.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal
