Dear Mr. Quarterson:

On November 4, 2005, Ohio EPA received your request to change the locations of the scrap tire storage at your Class II Scrap Tire Recovery Facility located at 14864 Lincoln Street S.E., Minerva, Stark County, Ohio. Additional drawings were submitted on February 9, 2006. The request proposed to change the locations used for the storage of whole scrap tires and processed scrap tires to accommodate additional processing equipment. The total number of scrap tire equivalents authorized for storage is not proposed to change.

Order Number 4 of the Director's Final Findings and Orders, dated December 18, 2003, required that all scrap tires be stored in locations and configurations provided in the plan drawings submitted on July 1, 2003.

Based on the review of this request, Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, LLC (Liberty), is hereby authorized to store all scrap tires in the locations and configurations provided in the plan drawings submitted on February 9, 2006, as part of this request.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release Liberty from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code; under the Federal Clean Water or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Acts; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the director's action. Notice of the filing
