**Re: County Environmental of Wyandot Sanitary Landfill, Wyandot County
Change to Permit-to-Install (PTI) Condition**

Dear Ms. Goodhall:

On July 23, 1999, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued PTI Number 03-10430 to County Environmental of Wyandot (CEW) for a vertical and lateral expansion of the County Environmental of Wyandot Sanitary Landfill (Facility) located in Wyandot County. Condition Number 22 of the PTI states:

“All results and laboratory reports of testing to confirm or evaluate the strength of materials for slope stability analysis as required by Section 1.3 of the QA/QC Plan contained in this PTI, shall be submitted to Ohio EPA at least 30 days prior to beginning construction of any component of the landfill which contains the materials so tested.”

In a letter dated August 18, 2006, CEW requested to modify Condition Number 22 to be consistent with the current version of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) that was revised in August 2003. OAC Rule 3745-27-08(G) requires that the preconstruction interface testing be submitted to Ohio EPA at least 7 days prior to the intended use of the materials.

Ohio EPA has completed a review of the August 18, 2006, request and hereby approves CEW's request by modifying Condition Number 22 of PTI Number 03-10430 as follows:

“All results and laboratory reports of testing to confirm or evaluate the strength of materials for slope stability analysis as required by Section 1.3 of the QA/QC Plan contained in this PTI, shall be submitted to Ohio EPA in accordance with the minimum time frames required in the regulations in effect at the time of the construction event.”

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from any requirements of applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release CEW

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or others from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

You are hereby notified that this action of the director of Ohio EPA is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to ORC Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Commission at the following address:
