PTI SUMMARY

This is a Final Permit to Install (PTI# 06-08185) to increase the authorized maximum daily waste receipt (AMDWR) of the Beech Hollow Sanitary Landfill (Facility), located on Township Road 353 approximately 3/4 mile north of the Appalachian Highway, approximately 2 miles northeast of Wellston, Ohio.

This permit authorizes an increase in the Facility's AMDWR from 2,500 tons to 4,000 tons, but Rumpke Waste, Inc. anticipates the average daily waste receipt to be 1,300 tons. The operational life of the landfill would be more than 63.1 years based on the average (expected) gate receipts, or 20.5 years based on the AMDWR. The proposed 178-acre solid waste disposal area, as authorized in PTI #06-7614 issued on March 25, 2005, remains unchanged.

This landfill currently has and will continue to incorporate into its construction such features as a composite (clay/geosynthetic membrane) liner system, a leachate collection and management system, a ground water monitoring system, an explosive gas extraction system, a final closure cap system, and 30 years of post-closure care.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the permit approval.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. Issuance of this permit does not relieve Rumpke Waste, Inc., of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
2. The Facility's AMDWR is hereby established to be 4,000 tons. This supersedes any previously established AMDWR for the Facility. This approval shall apply only to the increase in the Facility's AMDWR.
3. Nothing in this permit approval shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release Rumpke Waste, Inc., from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
4. Pursuant to ORC Sections 3745.11(Q) and (V), payment of the solid waste permit-to-install fee balance, in the amount of six hundred dollars (\$600) payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Attn.: Fiscal

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Administration, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio, 43216-1049. The fee balance shall be submitted not later than thirty (30) days after the effective date of this permit approval. Failure to timely submit the required fee balance will result in assessment of late penalties in accordance paragraphs (Q) and (V) of ORC Section 3745.11
