**Re: Pike Sanitation Landfill, Pike County
Request for Temporary AMDWR Increase Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC)
Rule 3745-37-14(D)(2)**

Dear Mr. Migyanko:

On February 11, 2008, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southeast District Office (SEDO) received a letter from Pike Sanitation, Inc. (Pike) requesting a temporary increase in the authorized maximum daily waste receipt (AMDWR) for the Pike Sanitation Landfill. Supplemental information and revisions to the AMDWR increase request were submitted on February 28, 2008 and March 18, 2008, along with endorsements for the increase from the Pike County Board of Commissioners on February 12, 2008, and from MASCO on March 20, 2008.

Pike requested the AMDWR be increased from the current permitted limit of 2,000 tons per day to 3,000 tons per day for a period of 90 days to allow for an increase in waste tonnage received from the ongoing cleanup of the Miller Salvage site.

The Miller Salvage site cleanup is currently performed by Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA), a contractor for MASCO, with oversight by USEPA. All waste is being removed for disposal at Pike Sanitation and Beech Hollow Landfills. Leachate generated at the site is being collected and transported to Chillicothe and Huntington, WV water treatment plants for disposal.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-37-14(D)(2) states that if the director makes the determination that an emergency exists affecting public health and safety which necessitates a temporary increase in the solid waste receipt at the facility, the director may authorize a temporary increase as necessary for up to a maximum of one hundred eighty consecutive days.

Based upon a review of the request and associated information, I am not able to make a determination that an emergency exists affecting public health and safety which necessitates a temporary AMDWR increase. I, therefore, decline to authorize the temporary AMDWR increase.
