Issuance of this permit does not constitute expressed or implied approval or agreement that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with the plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will operate in compliance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations, and does not constitute expressed or implied assurances that, if constructed and/or modified in accordance with those plans, specifications, and/or information accompanying the permit application, the above-described source of environmental pollutants will be granted the necessary operating permits and/or licenses. This permit is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof.

## PERMIT SUMMARY

This is a **DRAFT** permit (PTI Number 06-08439) which, if issued as a final permit, authorizes Coshocton Landfill, Inc. (Facility) to accept for disposal PCB-contaminated waste from the Zeidrich Dump site located in the Village of Minerva in West Township, Columbiana County, Ohio (Zeidrich Dump site).

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached permit.

## PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (permittee) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (municipal solid waste disposal facility).
2. Upon receiving authorization from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), pursuant to 40 CFR Part 761, to dispose PCB-contaminated waste in a solid waste landfill, PCB-contaminated waste from the Zeidrich Dump site may be accepted for disposal at the Facility. Acceptance of PCB-contaminated waste from any other site is not authorized. A copy of the authorization from USEPA shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Southeast District Office (SEDO) and the Coshocton County Health Department at least seven days prior to accepting any PCB-contaminated waste at the Facility.
3. Not later than seven days prior to commencing acceptance of the PCB-contaminated waste, the permittee shall submit to Ohio EPA, SEDO and the Coshocton County Health Department written notification of the anticipated start date so that the Facility can be routinely inspected by Ohio EPA, SEDO and the Coshocton County Health Department.
4. This permit grants approval to recirculate leachate only in accordance with the leachate recirculation plan contained within the permit application. This approval supersedes all previous authorizations regarding leachate recirculation at the Facility.
5. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.

6. This permit shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI Application Number 06-08439 received on September 11, 2008, with subsequent revisions received on February 18, 2009.
7. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this municipal solid waste disposal facility.
8. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27 and PTI Number 06-5547 issued on February 22, 2002.
9. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit shall not be interpreted to release the permittee from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
10. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes.
11. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M. No such asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material may be accepted without first obtaining the necessary permits from Ohio EPA.
