## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

The 401 Certification for the following general permit is being issued on December 1, 2008 as a final action with an effective date of December 1, 2008. Final actions are actions of the Director which are effective upon issuance or a stated effective date. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04, a Final Action may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC) filing an appeal within 30 days of notice of the final action. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Appeals Commission at 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
