RE: Final Action for Revocation of Class 1 Water Supply Certificate and Class 2 Wastewater Certificate

Dear Mr. Header:

On July 23, 2013, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") issued a proposed action revoking your Class 1 Water Supply Certificate and your Class 2 Wastewater Certificate issued to you by Ohio EPA pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 3745-7. This proposed action was mailed via certified mail.

On August 20, 2013, you filled a request for an adjudication hearing. On March 12, 2014, during a status conference for this case, you stated that you did not wish to go forward with a hearing. On March 19, 2014, a Status Conference Report confirmed that you were not interested in going forward with a hearing.


In light of the fact that during the March 12, 2014 status conference, you represented that you did not plan to go forward with a hearing, there remain no unresolved issues of law or fact requiring an adjudication hearing in this matter.

Your actions documented by Ohio EPA constitute the performance of the duties of an operator in a negligent or incompetent manner, the knowing or negligent submission of misleading, inaccurate or false reports, documents or applications, operation in a manner endangering the public health or welfare, operating in such a manner as to have violated provisions of Chapter 6109 and 6111 of the Revised Code. These alleged actions occurred during your employment with various facilities and involve actions related to your obligations as a certified operator. Pursuant to OAC 3745-7-12(A), the director may revoke the certificate of an operator upon finding that the operator has performed the duties of an operator in a negligent or incompetent manner, knowingly or negligently submission of misleading, inaccurate or false reports, documents or applications, operated in a manner endangering the public health or welfare, operated in such a manner as to have violated provisions of Chapter 6109 and 6111 of the Revised Code. Accordingly, I am revoking your Class 1 Water Supply certificate WS1-1014297-08 and Class 2 Wastewater Certificate WW2-1014297-92. This revocation is issued as a final action pursuant to ORC Chapter 119 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-49.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission.
