OF DRAFT GENERAL NPDES PERMIT
FOR BULK FUEL STORAGE FACILITIES**

Date of Issue of Public Notice: June 12, 2017

On the basis of staff review and application of standards and regulations, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency will issue a draft general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the statewide regulation of bulk fuel storage facilities. The draft permit will be issued as a final action unless the Director revises the draft after consideration of the record of a public hearing or written comments, or upon disapproval by the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Any person may submit comments on the draft permit and administrative record.

The NPDES General Permit for Bulk Fuel Storage Facilities (Permit No. OHB000003) is the third generation of this general permit. This permit would afford coverage to a majority of facilities requiring NPDES permit coverage to store large volumes of various fuels throughout the State of Ohio. The permit identifies who can be covered, how an entity obtains coverage, and how a permittee terminates coverage. The permit contains requirements for permittees to develop and implement a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) to minimize or eliminate the potential for contamination of storm water by industrial activities. The permit includes reporting requirements for all facilities, and also contains analytical monitoring requirements for most facilities covered.

The processing of this general permit and associated Notices of Intent for coverage is and will be done, respectively, in accordance with Ohio's antidegradation rule, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-1-05, and NPDES general permit rules, OAC 3745-38.

An Ohio EPA public hearing to accept comments on the draft general permit has been scheduled for 3:00 PM on August 10, 2017 in Conference Room B, Ohio EPA Lazarus Government Center, 50 West Town Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The public hearing will end when everyone in attendance has had an opportunity to provide comments related to the draft general permit. In lieu of attending the public hearing, written comments may be submitted as outlined in the following paragraph.

Interested persons are invited to submit written comments on this draft general permit. Comments should be submitted in person or by mail no later than 5:00 PM on August 17, 2017.
