APPLICABLE

REGULATIONS: 40 CFR Part 123.45

PURPOSE: To assure consistent reporting of non-compliance, and it applies to all major municipal and industrial and federal dischargers. This procedure covers the requirements for preparing the Quarterly Noncompliance Report according to 40 CFR Part 123.45.

POLICY: The U.S. EPA has issued instructions for preparing the Quarterly Non-compliance report, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Regulations: Noncompliance and Program Reporting. This regulation was last revised on August 20, 1987, and was an attempt to institute consistent reporting of noncompliance throughout the country.
