State Supplemental Life Insurance Policy:

1. The State of Ohio provides permanent employees the opportunity to buy supplemental term life insurance through a private company at state approved rates.
2. Employees must sign up for the supplemental life insurance within 90 days of their hire date or during open enrollment in increments of \$10,000 up to \$100,000 or six times their salary, whichever is less. Once enrolled, at open enrollment employees may sign up in increments of \$10,000 up to \$500,000 or six times their salary, whichever is less.
3. Life insurance may also be purchased for the employee's spouse & children.
