Re: Countywide Landfill's request for a time extension pursuant to Order 6.B

Dear Mr. Hamilton:

I have received your request for an extension to submit applicable permit applications and/or notifications for the backup (i.e., "emergency") generators within the time frame required by Order 6. B contained in the Director's Final Findings and Orders issued to Countywide Recycling & Disposal Facility ("Countywide") on March 28, 2007. Order 6. B, in part, states the following:

- 6.B Respondent shall also submit to Ohio EPA, not later than 30 days after the effective date of these Orders, the appropriate permit application, permit modification application, or notification required by OAC Chapters 3745-31 and 3745-77 for the backup power equipment installed pursuant to the requirements of these Orders. An extension of the specified application deadline date may be granted if Respondent submits written justification, two weeks prior to its due date, and if the Director concurs in writing.


Your request states that a 30-day extension is needed to allow time to identify the lowest [emitting] emissions units practical (i.e., backup/emergency). Additionally, you say that Countywide believes the generators will be subject to the requirements of the permit-by-rule exemptions in OAC Rule 3745-31-03(A)(4)(b) due to their size and projected maximum operating hours. You also stated that the extension will not impact the installation schedule for the backup generators.

After reviewing your request, I am granting a 30 day extension to the time frame specified in Order 6.B for the submittal of the applicable permit applications and/or notifications for the backup generators, provided that the increase in emissions associated with the "emergency generators" will not trigger the requirement for a PSD and/or nonattainment preconstruction review permit.
