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Meeting Scheduled for Sandusky-Clyde Energy's Draft Air Pollution Permit

Ohio EPA will hold a public information session and hearing on Thursday, Aug. 4, 2011, to accept comments on a draft air pollution control permit for a new electric power plant proposed to be built in Clyde. The public information session and hearing will begin at 6:30 p.m. in the Clyde High School auditorium, 1015 Race St.

Ohio EPA previously held a public meeting on the proposed Sandusky-Clyde Energy Solutions power plant in September 2010 and issued a permit to build the facility earlier this year. However, developers have chosen a new location for the plant, which requires a new air pollution control permit.

The new location will be in an industrial park at 300 Premier Drive, Clyde. The facility originally was to be constructed at 1357 McPherson Highway (U.S. 20). The plant's specifications are not changing. The company plans to install seven natural gas reciprocating internal combustion engines.

Air pollution emissions from the facility would include nitrogen oxide and carbon monoxide. If approved, the permit would limit the facility's annual emissions to 11.62 tons of carbon monoxide and 2.73 tons of nitrogen oxide. Emissions also would include up to 0.28 tons per year of volatile organic compounds. The maximum allowable emission levels are designed to protect human health and the environment. These levels are set in permits issued by Ohio EPA.

During the public meeting, representatives from Ohio EPA will present information about the draft permit and answer questions. A public hearing will immediately follow to allow the public to submit comments for the record regarding the draft permit.

Ohio EPA will accept written comments on the draft permit through August 12, 2011. All public comments will be taken into consideration before Ohio EPA decides whether to issue or deny the permit. The draft permit only addresses the natural gas electricity generating phase of the project.
