**Ohio EPA Workshop to be Held in Lancaster April 1;
State, Federal Help Available to Redevelop Blighted Properties in Small Communities**

Ohio EPA is offering a workshop to inform small and rural communities of the state and federal resources available to help redevelop [brownfields](#), or blighted properties. The workshop will be held Friday, April 1, 2011, from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., at the Fairfield County Library (3rd Floor), 219 N. Broad St., in Lancaster.

Speakers from Ohio EPA, Ohio Department of Development, U.S. EPA, U.S. Department of Agriculture and Kansas State University (which provides assistance to small communities through a U.S. EPA grant) will address the following topics:
