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Public Invited to Learn About Proposed Wesselman Road Sewer Phase II-A
Comments to be Accepted at October 24 Hearing

Ohio EPA will host a public meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Oct. 24, 2011, at the [Nathanael Greene Lodge Ballroom](#), 6394 Wesselman Road, Cincinnati, to discuss a permit application for the proposed Wesselman Road Sewer Phase II-A, Contract 2.

If the permit is issued, it would allow the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) to install 804 feet of 24-inch sanitary sewer, manholes and sewer taps from Wesselman Road to the Hampton Point Pump Station at Dent Road in Green Township. This may be part of a larger project.

The meeting will begin with an information session to explain the project. The audience will have an opportunity to ask questions of the presenter. A public hearing will immediately follow the information session. People wishing to offer testimony must observe time limits and time may not be donated to other speakers. Written testimony, charts, maps and visual aids also will be accepted and will be given equal consideration.

Written comments can be sent to the same address by Oct. 31. Comments received after that date may be considered as time allows but will not be considered part of the official record.
