
# System Fees

- State Disposal Fee: \$4.75
  - \$1.00 to Ohio EPA Hazardous Waste (\$13.9)
  - \$1.00 to Ohio EPA Solid Waste Fund (\$13.9)
  - \$2.50 to Ohio EPA Environmental Protection Fund (\$34.8)
  - \$0.25 to Soil and Water Conservation Districts (\$3.5)
- Total Income from State Fee (FY2012): \$66,200,000
- SWMD Fees:
  - Disposal Fee :
    - In-District Waste/Out-of-District/Out-of-State: \$1-2 /2-4/1-2
  - Generation Fee: \$0.50 to \$10.00
- Total SWMD Income (2011): \$78,607,755
- Host Community Fee: \$0.25

# System Fees

- **Construction & Demolition Debris Disposal Fee (at MSW landfill): \$1.60/ton (\$ .80/cu. yd.)**
- **\$.60 to licensing authority – HD or OEPA (ORC 3714.07)**
  - .06 to Ohio EPA
  - .06 to host county (by resolution)
  - .08 to host municipality (by resolution or ordinance)
  - (\$.40 - \$.60 retained by licensing authority)
- **\$.25 to Soil and Water Conservation Districts**
- **\$.75 to Recycling and Litter Prevention Grants**




# SWMD Revenue

# Top SWMD Funding Sources (2011)





# Tiered Disposal Fee (2011)

- 31 SWMDs have established a TDF (9 do not have a landfill)
- \$1-2/2-4/1-2 (ID, OOD, OOS)
- Total raised in 2011: \$22,795,751.28

# Generation and Contract Fees (2011)

## Generation Fees:

- Currently utilized by 26 SWMDs
- Ranges from \$0.50/ton to \$10/ton
- Total raised in 2011: \$23, 177,552.28

## Contract Fees:

- Currently utilized by 16 SWMDs
- Ranges from \$0.50/ton to \$7.44/ton
- Total raised in 2011: \$5,864,852.46

# Other Sources/Trends of Note (2011)

**Recycling Revenue:** \$6,552,038.40

- Highest since 2008

**User Fees:** \$1,603,398.05

- Steady increase over last few years

**County Contributions:** \$87,605.51

- Large drop from previous years

**Joint Use Agreements:** \$40,569.09

- Large drop from previous years
