Public Notice: Rulemaking governing Secondary Maximum Contaminant Rules (No Change)

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) is proposing “no change” to rules 3745-82-01, 3745-82-03 and 3745-82-04 of the Ohio Administrative Code. DDAGW has reviewed these rules to satisfy the five-year rule review requirements of section 106.03 and 106.031 of the Ohio Revised Code.

OAC Chapter 3745-82 describes and establishes monitoring requirements and definitions for secondary maximum contaminant levels. Click on each rule number to review it.
