PCB wastes regulated under the Toxic Substances Control Act.

The disposal of polychlorinated byphenyl (PCB)-containing dielectric fluids and electric equipment containing such fluids authorized for use and regulated under 40 CFR Part 761 and that are hazardous only because ~~they~~such items fail the test for the toxicity characteristic leaching procedure (EPA hazardous waste numbers D018 to D043 only) are exempt from regulation under Chapters 3745-51, 3745-52, 3745-53, 3745-54 to 3745-57, 3745-65 to 3745-69, 3745-205, 3745-256, and 3745-270 of the Administrative Code, rules 3745-50-40 to 3745-50-235 of the Administrative Code, and the requirement to notify Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA of regulated waste activity.
