

The myRCRAid component of the RCRAInfo Industry Application is the US Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) solution to allow RCRA sites (generators; treatment, storage, and disposal facilities; transporters, et. al.) to electronically submit Ohio EPA's 9029, the RCRA Subtitle C Site Identification Form.

BENEFITS

- ❖ **QUICKER TURNAROUND** – no paper forms and mail process; the form can be promptly reviewed and approved by the regulatory agency
- ❖ **LESS DATA ENTRY** – for existing IDs, the information from the previous submission is populated, making it quick and easy to update and submit
- ❖ **BETTER DATA QUALITY** – built-in edit checks prevent submission of data that does not conform to the business rules; reduces the need for the regulatory agency to call for corrections to a submission
- ❖ **SIMPLE ID REQUESTS** – may request an EPA handler identification number for locations that don't already have one
- ❖ **REAL-TIME COMMUNICATION** – automatic email notifications keep both the industry user and the Ohio EPA apprised of the submission status
- ❖ **EASY SITE ORGANIZATION** – may associate your account with multiple sites, making it easier to maintain records for a company with numerous locations
- ❖ **BUILT-IN FILING CABINET** – history of submissions makes it easy to view electronic records submitted over time
- ❖ **ELECTRONICALLY SIGN SUBMISSIONS** – one-time real-time identity proofing requiring your home mailing address, birth date, and the last 4 numbers of your social security number allows for the immediate ability to sign and submit data; paper identity proofing process also available (may take two or more weeks for approval)
- ❖ **VARIETY OF ROLES** – users may be given permissions consistent with their duties
 - **SITE MANAGEMENT ROLE** – approve and assign user roles for their site; edit, sign, and submit data
 - **CERTIFIER ROLE** – edit, sign, and submit data
 - **PREPARER ROLE** – edit data
 - **VIEWER ROLE** – view data

HOW TO GET STARTED
