Who is eligible?

Interns must be enrolled in a college program directly related to the position or have graduated within the past quarter/semester.

Majors we look for:

environmental science, biology, chemistry, engineering, geographical information systems, natural resources, botany, zoology, laboratory sciences, IT and legal.



Focus your work on opportunities including projects in wetlands, water quality modeling, macroinvertebrate or fish sampling, permits, drinking water safety, air pollution and laboratory analysis.

Show what you have learned as you collect physical, chemical and biological data, assist during inspections or help measure biological diversity in Ohio's streams.

Earn a paycheck as you build your resume.

Most internship opportunities occur in the summer with job openings posted in January to early February. Winter internships are often part-time.
