RECEIPT OF RENEWAL APPLICATION

On April 30, 2021, Ohio EPA received a Renewal Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit Application (Permit Application) from Solvay Specialty Polymers USA, LLC (Solvay), U.S. EPA Identification Number OHD 981 529 688, for its facility located at 17005 State Rt. 7, Marietta, OH 45750. Solvay currently owns and operates a commercial chemical manufacturing facility which produces heat-resistant thermoplastic polymers used in the medical, food, electronic, chemical processing, and automotive industries. The purpose of the Permit Application is to allow Solvay to continue managing hazardous waste in containers, treat hazardous waste as necessary in an emergency basin surface impoundment unit, and perform corrective action and post closure care activities.

For the Permit Application to receive final approval, Ohio EPA must determine that the Permit Application is complete and meets appropriate standards and that the applicant has a history of compliance with relevant environmental laws and demonstrates sufficient reliability, expertise, and competency to operate a hazardous waste facility.

As a precautionary response to COVID-19, Ohio EPA is currently operating with most of its staff working remotely. Due to this, Ohio EPA is unable to mail out a mailing list notification and is posting this notification electronically.
