**OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL MODIFIED HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT**  
**Retriev Technologies, Inc.**

On May 21, 2020, the Director of Ohio EPA approved the issuance of a Final Class 2 Permit Modification to Retriev Technologies, Inc. (Retriev) for its facility located at 265 Quarry Rd., Lancaster, OH 43130 in Fairfield County, to transition to a weekly inspection frequency for various points of inspections that are not required by regulation to be performed daily and remove various points of inspection that have no relevance to its RCRA Permit, as these items pertain to health and safety or permitted air emissions and are addressed by other regulatory programs (OSHA, PTIO). Retriev operates a battery recycling and reclamation facility. This modified permit will allow Retriev to make the requested changes. The EPA ID number for this facility is OHD 071 654 958. To issue this final permit, Ohio EPA determined that the modification application is complete and meets appropriate standards.

As a precautionary response to COVID-19, Ohio EPA is currently operating with most of its staff working remotely. Due to this, Ohio EPA is unable to mail out a mailing list notification and is posting this notification electronically. You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
