Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued the final general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit (OHK000003) to renew coverage to discharges from select household sewage treatment systems (HSTS) serving one, two or three family dwellings or other residential dwellings as defined by Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3701-29 in the State of Ohio. The issuance of this final NPDES permit addresses the renewal of the existing NPDES Permit numbers OHK000002 and OHL000002, which expired on December 31, 2016.
