



Compliance Inspections and Verification Reviews

Overview: This dashboard reflects the Agency's efforts to verify compliance with permits, environmental rules and other requirements for the facilities we regulate. These activities are broken down by month and Agency program. An inspection is defined as Agency personnel conducting a field visit to a site or facility. Other compliance monitoring activities include reviewing submittals that are required by the regulations, such as compliance reports, monitoring data, etc. To a large degree, compliance monitoring activities are proportional to the number of facilities that are regulated in various programs. For example, the large numbers in the drinking water program reflect the Agency's work in reviewing monitoring and analytical reports that are submitted by thousands of public water systems each month.
