Instructions

Water systems which exceed the lead or copper action level must monitor for lead and copper at each entry point to the distribution system. Water samples for lead and copper analyses should be collected from each entry point during the same monitoring period that the water system exceeded the lead or copper action level. The sampling location should be flushed before collecting the sample. The analyses results must be reported on this form, along with the water quality parameter analyses required.

Return the completed report to your Ohio EPA district office no later than 10 days after the month in which results were received. Keep a copy in your records for at least 12 years.
