Sally Hamlin will provide an overview of the RAD program. RAD is a voluntary program U. S. EPA administers to work with utilities, local and state governments, retailers, manufacturers and disposal companies to reduce pollution resulting from improper disposal of refrigerated appliances.

Sam Sirkin will provide an overview of Recleim's process for recycling end of life appliances that contain refrigerants.

Anne Fiehrer-Flaig will provide a summary of the Butler County Recycling and Solid Waste District's appliance collection program, including the District's work with the RAD program and Recleim's recycling services.
