Dear Director Stevenson,

On May 27, 2019 Montgomery County experienced significant storm damage from the tornados that hit our communities. On May 28, 2019, the Montgomery County Commissioners passed a Resolution declaring a State of Emergency for Montgomery County.

As you know, the Montgomery County Solid Waste Management District (the "District") received approval from you of the District's ratified Solid Waste Management Plan (the "Plan"). Contained in the Plan is our generation fee in the amount of \$3.00 per ton.

In response to the impact to the storm damage and to assist our local governmental jurisdictions impacted by the storm, the District is respectfully requesting an exemption from your office for the collection of the District's generation fee effective May 31, 2019 until July 30th, 2019 on only storm related debris collected at the following facilities:

- Hamilton County: ID#33318 Rumpke Sanitary Landfill Municipal Solid Waste Landfill, 10795 Hughes Rd. Cincinnati 45251
- Montgomery County: ID#32719 Stony Hollow Landfill Inc., Municipal Solid Waste Landfill, 2460 S. Gettysburg Avenue Dayton 45417
- Montgomery County: ID#54245 Montgomery County South Transfer Facility, Municipal Solid Waste Transfer Facility, 2550 Sandridge Dr., Dayton 45439
- Preble County: ID#35825 Preble County Sanitary Landfill Municipal Solid Waste Landfill, 4239 State Rte127S, Eaton 45320
