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Permits to Install; Professional Engineer Requirement

PURPOSE: To ensure professional design and construction of all wastewater works and to ensure that industry standards are followed.

POLICY: All detailed plans submitted to Ohio EPA for permits to install and plan approval which are for projects involving the expenditure of public funds or which will subsequently be operated and/or maintained by a public agency shall be prepared by or under the supervision of a professional engineer with registration in the state of Ohio. All plans shall be signed and sealed by that engineer.

All other plans submitted to the agency for permits to install and plan approvals should, whenever possible, be prepared by or under the supervision of a professional engineer with registration in the state of Ohio. If prepared by a registered engineer, the plans shall be signed and sealed by that engineer.

All permits to install and plan approvals issued by the agency shall also be performed by and/or reviewed by a professional engineer. All engineering reports shall be signed by a professional engineer.
